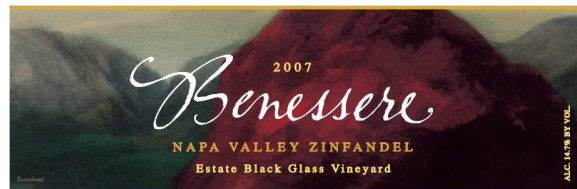

WINERY TASTING NOTES

We call our vineyard "Black Glass" for the obsidian arrowheads, spearheads and chippings left by the Native American-Wappo Indian Tribe who hunted and lived on the land from BC to the 1800's.

We rush to take the hand-harvested fruit directly from the vineyard and gently destem it into small, open topped tanks for cold-soaking and fermentation. The total maceration time for our BG Zin in 2007 was 31 days. The new wine was drained and the skins were gently pressed, and then the wine was placed into a combination of new 60% American oak and 40% once-used French oak barrels for aging. The wine was racked off the sediment twice during the 15 months in barrel and bottled without fining or filtration to retain the maximum in flavor and complexity.

"Black Glass" is our well respected Zinfandel from the Benessere Estate Vineyard. It is known for its distinctive fruit and velvety textural characteristics. There are spicy cherry and bright blackberry jam aromas that are complemented by clove and allspice that carry through to the palate. We suggest pairing this complete wine with partners such as rib-eye steaks, lamb shank, cabot blue cheese, and Belgian chocolates. The 2007 vintage will age well for the next six to ten years.

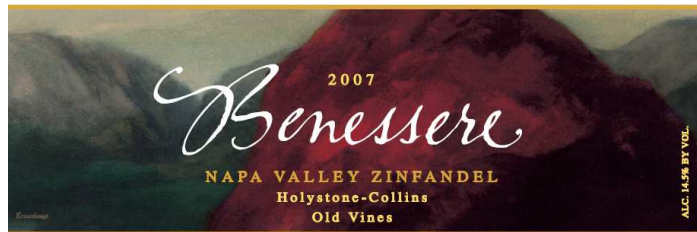

WINERY TASTING NOTES

A "Holystone" is used by Naval Cadets to scrub the deck on a carrier or destroyer. As Bill Collins is a Napa Valley legend, and former naval officer, he felt this was a good name for the "Collins Family Vineyard". Their vineyard, planted in 1922 by Chinese immigrants, is a living testimonial to California viticulture. These mature vines are gnarled yet statuesque, and produce a wine of great depth and elegance which bespeaks their heritage and origin. Winemakers love to work with old vines as they typically have a reduced yield in the vineyard and resultant concentrated flavors in the wine.

2007 was a great vintage for the "Old Vines". After destemming, the must was "cold-soaked" for three days at 40 F. Hand punching the must for 23 days allowed the flavor and color to be extracted gently and completely. The wine went directly into small French and American Oak barrels after a light pressing of the skins. It stayed in barrel for 15 months before being bottled on April 15, 2009. This is a great wine to drink by itself or to pair with a wide range of dishes. The 2007 is deep ruby with a purple tinge in color, has violets and strawberry compote along with elegant spicy notes on the nose and has a beautiful entry, full mid-palate and lush finish. This Zinfandel is not a simple, fruit forward wine, but has elements of earth, soft, yet ageworthy tannins, and a clean balanced elegance. It is a great accompaniment to roast duck, baby back ribs, porcini risotto and camembert cheese. It will age well for the next 5 to 7 years.
